## ENDOWMENT FUNDS

Planned gifts to the SPCA can be directed to existing endowment funds that serve a specific purpose, or the gift can be unspecified, in which case the Board of Directors will decide the allocation of the gift, based on available programs and needs of the SPCA.

Donations or bequests may be made to existing endowment funds in the following areas of need:

- **General Operating:** The Best Friends Fund provides funding for SPCA operating costs to ensure the long-term financial viability of the SPCA so it can continue to serve the animals in Martinsville-Henry County for generations to come.
- **Medical:** Provides funding for the medical care SPCA animals need, including critical care, as well as in-house medical equipment and veterinary capacity and services.
- **Spay & Neuter Services and Education:** Provides funding for spay & neuter services to help control animal overpopulation and education programming.
- **Humane Education:** Provides funding for humane education to instill compassion and kindness for animals and impart how to provide quality care for them.
